CATEGORIES

1. Fine Art Gallery **Member**: On the map/ Membership dues for 2023 **\$100.00**
Our original gallery guidelines of a year-round gallery with 2 or more artists showing and /or selling original fine art that has the artist's name on it, and a biography available for customers.

Agree to:

1. Place of business must be within 10 km radius of Hwy 21
2. Be physically open and available to visitors a minimum of six (6) months a year.
3. Post your hours of operation and strictly adhere to them. You are required to be open for the hours you publish
4. Agree that the Arts Trail on 21 Committee will be the deciding judge on the category into which a new applicant will be accepted

NEW in 2023

2. Creative Art **Partner**: On the map / Membership dues for 2023 **\$100.00** Shops and galleries that show and sell:
 1. Handmade arts and crafts as well as individual artist paintings
 2. Working artist studios that are free standing from their residential property and open to the public (a min of 6 Mo's a year) including pottery, painting, textiles, jewelry, iron work, sculpture etc
 3. Framing stores
 4. Craft and art workshop venues.

Agree to:

- Promote handmade, artisan (but not mass produced/ manufactured) items
- Sell or display art that is made by the artist, or obtained on consignment from the actual artist/ group
- Place of business must be within 10 km radius of Hwy 21
- Be physically open and available to visitors a minimum of six (6) months a year.
- Post your hours of operation and strictly adhere to them. You are required to be open for the hours you publish
- Agree that the Arts Trail on 21 Committee will be the deciding judge on the category into which a new applicant will be accepted
